4. Continue through Cambridge (5 Traffic Lights) to intersection of Church Creek Rd. (Wal-Mart on Right). Take that left at that intersection.
5. Turn left into the Hyatt Regency Hotel (Heron Boulevard).

DIRECTIONS TO THE HOLIDAY INN EXPRESS FROM DC

1. Follow the above directions to the Cambridge, Maryland
2. The Holiday Inn Express is located on your immediate right, just upon arrival into Cambridge; if you pass Heron Boulevard, you have gone to far.
